MILITARY SPECIFICATION

COUPLER, ANTENNA CU-351(*)/AR
AND
COUPLER, ANTENNA CU-509(*)/AR

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-C-18277B(WEP) dated 15 February 1961 and has been approved by the Bureau of Naval Weapons, Department of the Navy.

Page 1, paragraph 1.1: Delete "50-150 watt" and substitute

"50-185 watt average and 600 watt PEP"

Make this same change wherever "50-150 watt" is used in this specification.

Page 1, paragraph 1.2, under "Type Designation": Delete "MT-1660()/AR" and substitute

"MT-(*)/AR"

Make this same change wherever "MT-1660(*)/AR" is used in this specification

Page 1, paragraph 2.1, after "to the extent specified herein:" Add

"(See 6.2)"

Page 4, after paragraph 3.2.2.1: Add

"3.2.2.2 Explosion-proof and Sand and Dust - The equipment shall not be required to comply with the explosion-proof and sand and dust requirements of Specification MIL-E-5400."

Page 6, paragraph 3.2.14: Add

"except as follows:

3.2.14.1 Conducted Interference, Power Leads - The limits for Conducted Interference on the Power Leads are raised 6 db above the applicable requirements of Specification MIL-I-6181.
