This amendment forms a part of MIL-E-1/1096D, dated 24 February 1981, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

PAGE 1

Delete "The complete requirements for procuring the electron tube described herein shall consist of this document and the latest issue of Specification MIL-E-1." and insert "The requirements for acquiring the electron tube described herein shall consist of this document and the latest revision of MIL-PRF-1."

Under GENERAL: delete "Qualification - Required" and insert "Qualification - Not Required".

PAGES 2 and 3

All places: delete "Quality conformance inspection" and insert "Conformance inspection".

Delete in its entirety: the column "AQL (percent defective)" and all numerical values tabulated therein.

PAGE 3

Conformance inspection, part 3, Method 1501, Intermittent life, NOTES column: Delete "7" and substitute "7,11".

Conformance inspection, part 3, Method 1501, Intermittent life, Conditions column: Delete "TA = room" and "Group E".

PAGE 4

NOTES, add the following note:

"11. The life-test sample shall consist of 10 tubes per lot and not 1 tube failure shall be permitted. In the event of rejection of the first sample, a second sample of 20 tubes shall be selected from the lot. Acceptance shall then be based on the second samples which shall be tested with no tube failures."

PAGE 5
