
2nd Quarter, FY 2004

Quarterly Update:

DSCC serves as the Preparing Activity or technical agent for thousands of standardization documents covering a wide variety of electronic components and other items. Our engineers and technicians coordinate and prepare technical documents in 85 Federal Supply Classes and provide engineering support to DoD customers using these documents. Customers are able to view or download electronic copies of the specifications, standards, handbooks, drawings, and commercial item descriptions from our web site. Documents available for download from our web site are currently over 16,600.

Our web site reflects the current industry/customer trend of viewing documents online, instead of downloading them. Online viewing gives customers the ability to get information from selected portions of a document without having to needlessly download the entire document. The most accessed areas on our web site for this quarter have been the Military Performance Specifications (MIL-PRFs), Military Standards (MIL-STDs), and the Standard Microcircuit Drawings (SMDs).
