

**Additional Questions & Answers from Site Visit / Pre-Proposal Conferences
(Not included in Amendment 0001 Published Questions)**

Reference: Section C, Page 115 B. Parts 2A and 2B- Process b. 12 Customer Service Support to include: Plan for providing technical support to customers. **Question:** What does DLA mean by technical support?

Technical support is support provided to the customer

Reference: Section B, Page 5

CLIN 0001 (Commercially Sourced). For each item, there shall be a fixed unit price per unit of issue for contractor sourced part delivered to the designated bin or location in support of production/ maintenance lines at Tobyhanna Army Depot (TYAD). The price shall include:

1. The price(s) obtained by the Contractor from its vendor(s) for the replenishment parts and industrial hardware; (these CLINS will not include facility cost)
2. Transportation and expenses related to the preparation for delivery requirements (preservation, packaging, packing, marking and bar coding) to move the replenishment parts and hardware from the vendor's facility to the contractor; and
3. Profit

CLIN 0002 (World-Wide Demand Items). For each item, there shall be a fixed unit price per unit of issue for contractor sourced part delivered to the destination designated in the delivery order in support of World-wide Demand (WWD) outside the TYAD maintenance lines. The price will not include facility cost. The price shall include:

1. The price(s) obtained by the Contractor from its vendor(s) for the replenishment parts and industrial hardware;
2. Transportation and expenses related to the preparation for delivery requirements (preservation, packaging, packing, marking and bar coding) to move the replenishment parts and hardware from the vendor's facility and ultimately to the destination designated in the delivery order (which is limited to locations within the continental limits of the United States, excluding Alaska and Hawaii).
3. Profit

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CLIN 0007AA (Commercially Sourced). For each item, there shall be a fixed unit price per unit of issue for contractor sourced part delivered to the designated bin or location in support of production/ maintenance lines at Letterkenny Army Depot (LEAD). The price shall include:

4. The price(s) obtained by the Contractor from its vendor(s) for the replenishment parts and industrial hardware; (these CLINS will not include facility cost)
5. Transportation and expenses related to the preparation for delivery requirements (preservation, packaging, packing, marking and bar coding) to move the replenishment parts and hardware from the vendor's facility to the contractor; and
6. Profit

CLIN 0007AB (World-Wide Demand Items). For each item, there shall be a fixed unit price per unit of issue for contractor sourced part delivered to the destination designated in the delivery order in support of

World-wide Demand (WWD) outside the LEAD maintenance lines. The price will not include facility cost. The price shall include:

4. The price(s) obtained by the Contractor from its vendor(s) for the replenishment parts and industrial hardware; (these CLINs will not include facility cost)
5. Transportation and expenses related to the preparation for delivery requirements (preservation, packaging, packing, marking and bar coding) to move the replenishment parts and hardware from the vendor's facility and ultimately to the destination designated in the delivery order (which is limited to locations within the continental limits of the United States, excluding Alaska and Hawaii).
6. Profit

The listing of items to be included within the price of the Commercially Sourced and World-wide Demand Items does not include General & Administrative (G&A) expense. The only mention of G&A in this sections describing the price buildup of each CLIN is in CLIN 0004 and CLIN 0007AD.

Question: Was it the Government's intent that all G&A costs for commercially sourced items be included in CLINS 0004 and 0007AD? Because the actual G&A cost of the items is an unknown due to the actual quantities to be acquired being an indefinite amount, will the government consider requesting the G&A amount for each commercially sourced item be applied within the price of the item? This will prevent overpayment by the government in the event the demand quantities do not materialize and the contractor not recouping its full expenses should the demand quantities exceed those in the RFP. Further, as items are added or deleted to these CLINS, CLIN 0004 and 0007AD would also need to be repriced to account for G&A of new items.

G&A is to be included in the proposed cost for CLINs 0004 and 0007AD.

Section L, Pages 112 & 113, Part V.A. Can the Government provide a list of the last twelve months of history of commercial items under CLINs 0001 and 0007AA in order to understand the type of items provided? Information to be provided on an excel spreadsheet with separate tabs for TYAD and LEAD. Data to include: NSN or Part number, Quantity, Annual demand frequency and Unit of Issue.

No, the ADQ was provided on the IPV website. That ADQ is what DLA is showing as the demand quantity for the item over the past 12 months.

Section L, Pages 112 & 113, Part V.A. Can the Government provide a list of the last twelve months of history of WWD items under CLINs 0002 and 0007AB in order to understand the type of items purchased? Information to be provided on an excel spreadsheet with separate tabs for TYAD and LEAD. Data to include: customer requisition data, date of order, NSN or Part number, Quantity and Unit of Issue.

No, the ADQ was provided on the IPV website. That ADQ is what DLA is showing as the demand quantity for the item over the past 12 months.

Section I, Page 98, paragraph I17D05, why is the period of performance for this requirement only five years and the previous solicitation for TYAD was for eight years?

Based on industry and DLA HQ feedback, a 5 year contract is determined to be in the best interest of the Government at this time.

Attachment 1 contains the 1 year and 3 year Bin and WWD demand for Commercially Sourced Items; however there is no demand data for VMI inventory. Will the government provide demand data for the VMI inventory?

Facility cost would be the cost charged to the contractor for housing materiel.

Question: CLIN 0004 and CLIN 0007AD request that offerors give a material management fee all active items. There is a worksheet for active TYAD items but no spreadsheet for active LEAD items. Will a list of active LEAD items be posted? Also, the TYAD Active list has 989 but CLIN 0004 requests a fee for 3664 active items. Will you please provide clarification for CLINs 0004 and 0007AD as to how many NSNs are active?

CLIN 0004 has 3664 "Active" items as indicated on the spreadsheet tab. CLIN 0007AD has 3707 "Active" items as indicated on the spreadsheet tab.

Question: Are there page limitations for each Volume? If not, does the Government have a recommended page limitation?

No, limit but past performance must be relevant over the last 3 years.

Reference: Section C , Page 64 , Paragraph 7.7

Question: Will you please provide clarification as to if there will be Government provided warehousing space and if so, what the square footage of that space will be?

Per 7.7 Office and Warehousing Facilities, "On-base and warehouse space may not be available at the customer site(s). Consequentially, the Contractor shall be required to obtain off-site office and storage space, appropriately furnished and staffed to accomplish the receipt of supplies, inventory control, quality control, handling, temporary storage and ultimate distribution of the spare parts or industrial hardware in accordance with requirements of this contract."

Question: The solicitation states that the Government will make an award on an All or None basis. Does that mean that all of the NSNs on the core list will be awarded or will NSNs be awarded on an individual basis?

There will be 1 award but all offerors must submit a price on all items on all CLINs (0001-0007 (including 0007s subCLINs))
