### DOD Small Business Policy (FAR Part 19)

The National and DOD policy on small business, as originally set forth in the Armed Services Procurement Act of 1947 (Title 10 United States Code (U.S.C.) 2301), provides that a fair proportion of the total purchases and contracts for supplies and services for the Government shall be placed with small business concerns. This fair proportion concept encompasses both contracts and subcontracts.

Section 2(a) of the Small Business Act of 1958, as amended (15 U.S.C. 631), and Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 19.2 set forth additional policy guidance to achieve this fair proportion. The Small Business Act of 1958 provides that it is the declared policy of the Congress that the Government should aid, counsel, assist, and protect, insofar as possible, the interests of small business concerns in order to preserve free competitive enterprise, to ensure that a fair proportion of the total purchases and contracts or subcontracts for property and services for the Government (including but not limited to contracts or subcontracts for maintenance, repair, and construction) be placed with small business enterprises, to ensure that a fair proportion of the total sales of Government property be made to such enterprises, and to maintain and strengthen the overall economy of the nation.

**DSCC makes every attempt to afford small businesses an equitable opportunity to compete for all contracts which they are capable of fulfilling. We have an on-going program to locate additional small business suppliers and include them in our database. We are also involved with other Federal, State, and Local agencies and other organizations for the purpose of providing information and assistance to small business concerns.**

The Procurement Gateway allows prospective government contractors to perform comprehensive and detailed searches against Request for Quotation (RFQ) and Award documents. Flexible search options permit the user to identify RFQs and Awards using a variety of search criteria including solicitation, Purchase Request Number (YPI), and National Stock Number (NSN). Users may also search the Procurement Gateway by providing keywords, data ranges, and Federal Supply Class (FSC). All RFQs and Awards are stored in digital format and may be viewed online. Please note that RFQs and Awards are available in Portable Document Format (PDF) and accessing them requires using the free [Adobe Acrobat](#) plug-in.



► Check out our new [User Profile](#) or [Collection Download](#) features. The [User Profile](#) option allows registered users to create and customize searches against account-specific profiles. Profile-based searches locate data that is important to you! The [Collection Download](#) option allows users to search and collect files on RFQs by the FSC search criteria. Users can collect multiple RFQs and have the Procurement Gateway zip those files up for you online, instantly! To conserve server resources, Collection Download requests are limited to **4 MB** per request. Once the request has been processed successfully, users can download the zip file immediately, or access the URL within the next 24 hours. # Vendor Roadmap for Doing Business with DSCC

## Getting Started

### Administrative

- To do business with DSCC, vendors need a **D-U-N-S number** from [Dun and Bradstreet](#).
- Vendors must register in the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) System, DUNS number, [Central Contractor Registration \(CCR\)](#) through the Defense Logistics Information Service (DLIS). If you do not have a CAGE code, one will be assigned to you when you complete the CCR registration. Click on the following [to update your name, address, phone and fax numbers](#)
- An [on-line CAGE code search](#) is available for looking up your company or another company's CAGE code.
- A financial account capable of receiving electronic funds transfers is a mandatory requirement, and is provided in the CCR registration.
- Credit card ordering using the government VISA card is gaining popularity
- Fax or E-mail capability to receive your monthly activity reports distributed by the [Vendor Link](#) program is essential
- [Electronic Commerce](#) is growing and you should check it out

### View DSCC Solicitations

- Only solicitations estimated under the Simplified Acquisition Threshold (SAT), less than \$100,000 are available electronically. The solicitations are in HTML format, they can be viewed at [DSCC RFQs](#)
- No additional software capabilities are required.
- If the solicitation is not available electronically, and under the Simplified Acquisition Threshold (less than \$100,000), check with the assigned buyer. The DSCC Buyer Search may be found at [Buyer Search](#) . If the buyer is not listed, please call the Business Counseling Center at (614) 692-3541.
- If the solicitation is estimated over the Simplified Acquisition Threshold (greater than \$100,000) or the solicitation has special clauses attached ("Special Q's") contact the Industry Coordination Office at (614) 692-1775 or e-mail [Indcoord@dsc.dla.mil](mailto:Indcoord@dsc.dla.mil)

### Getting Started

#### DSCC Bidset Interface

The [Bidset Interface](#) allows Engineering Data Lists (EDLs) and digitized drawings for **open DSCC procurements** to be electronically retrieved by the public.

Drawings that are **not** in electronic format, are classified, or have restrictions on dissemination may be ordered by clicking on "Manual Request" at [DSCC Bidset Interface](#).

DSCC Solicitations identified as having an associated (non-classified) drawing are identified by the following icon,  immediately after the NSN field in the results set of any Custom Query.

The digitized drawings are in CALS RASTER format (MIL-PRF-28002C), so a CALS RASTER format viewer program is required to view the drawings.

Below are examples of products that can be used to view images downloaded from this site. This There may be times when the drawing for an open solicitation is only an example list of what viewers are available. It in no means stresses any preferences to one viewer over another. ## Technical Requirements and Registration for DIBBS Internet Quoting

- **Technical Requirements**

In order to conduct transactions over the secure portion of DIBBS (submit electronic quotes on RFQs), vendors must register with DSCC in order to receive a logon account and password.

All transactions conducted over the secure portion of DIBBS will be encrypted and authenticated using a VeriSign Digital ID and Netscape secure socket layer (SSL) technology.

DIBBS requires **128 bit encryption browser**, [Netscape Navigator™ 4.0 \(or above\)](#) or [Microsoft Internet Explorer™ 4.0 \(or above\)](#), with Cookies and JAVA Script enabled. DIBBS will not function as intended when accessed through other browser software. You may click on the browser name to go to their web site to download your free browser.

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**Note:** Problems have been reported when using Netscape 6.1 browser. Our technical staff is evaluating the problem now. Until the problem is solved and you prefer using a Netscape browser, we recommend using a lower version.

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If you are using [Netscape Navigator™](#), the key icon at the lower left should be solid. If you are using [Microsoft Internet Explorer™](#), a padlock icon should appear at the lower right. These indicate that the link to DIBBS server is secure.

#### **About ABVS**

The Automated Best Value System (ABVS), formerly called the Automated Best Value Model, is a computerized system that collects a vendor's existing past performance data and translates it into a numeric score. The contracting officer then uses the score as an additional evaluation factor when making best value award decisions.

DLA assigns an ABVS score to each vendor based on the vendor's past performance. Vendors receive scores for performance in each federal supply class (FSC scores). The FSC scores are based on DLA consolidated performance history. A vendor may have multiple FSC scores but will have only one DLA score, which is a compilation of the vendor's FSC scores for all business conducted with DLA.

#### **Calculated monthly, ABVS scores are in effect for a month**

The DLA system uses 24 months of past performance history as the standard rating period. Each monthly update includes data through the 5th of the month.

The ABVS score is a combination of a vendor's delivery and quality scores and the scores range from zero to a perfect score of 100. If a vendor's score is less than 100, DLA provides the negative data that impacts that score.

The delivery score reflects all lines shown as delinquent during the rating period. For administrative purposes, the delivery-rating period excludes the most recent 60 days. For ABVS, delinquent lines represent shipments not shipped and/or received in their entirety by the contract delivery date.



## DSCC Automated Best Value System Program (ABVS)

### Vendor Programs

The quality score reflects validated contractor-caused product non-conformances/lab test failures and packaging non-conformances during the rating period. For administrative purposes, the rating period for quality excludes the most recent 30 days.

The 30 and 60 day offset periods are not grace periods.

Contractor caused discrepancies, regardless of corrective action, will be reflected in ABVS as an indicator of past performance. The repair, replacement or reimbursement of quality and packaging defects will not provide relief of negative ABVS data.

If your records reflect negative quality data, they are listed with one of the following Discrepancy Codes:

- A1 - A5 Stored Material Deficiencies
- C1 - C6 Supplies Damaged or with Expired Shelf-Life
- L1 - L8 Wood Product Deficiencies
- P0 - P8 Packaging Deficiencies
- Q1 - Q7 Product Quality Deficiencies
- T1 - T6 Technical Data Deficiencies
- W0 - W9 Wrong Item/Incomplete Item Shipped
- X1 - XL Damaged Material

### **Scores are used in best value award decisions**

Because buyers use ABVS scores as an additional evaluation factor in making best value award decisions, you should review your data carefully. Negative data affects your company's ABVS score.

### **You do not receive mailed notices of your negative data**

Your negative performance data will be posted before it is reflected in the ABVS score (preview period), to give you an opportunity to review and verify data. Negative data must be challenged within the preview period to assure corrections are posted before it is included in the calculation of the score.

Check your data regularly. ABVS scoring is a continuous process, and while you may not have negative data this month, it could appear next month.

### **Challenging data**

After reviewing your data, you may challenge any record for which you take exception, submitting challenges and substantiating evidence (e.g., shipping invoices, the Bill of Lading or the UPS manifest, signed DD250s, modifications, letters, etc.) to the ABVS administrator. The "center" data field will identify the appropriate focal point. Challenges may be mailed or faxed to the applicable center as follows:



## DSCC Automated Best Value System (Continued)

While you may challenge negative data at any time, it is to your advantage to challenge negative data during the preview period, before it has an opportunity to be reflected in the ABVS score.

You should review performance data on a monthly basis at a minimum. Failure to challenge will be interpreted as your agreement the data are accurate.

When a challenge is received, the ABVS score will be flagged. The flag will remain until the challenge is resolved. If an offer under evaluation involves a challenged score, the contracting officer will consider the nature of the challenged data and its relevance to the acquisition as part of the award decision.

The ABVS administrator will adjust the ABVS score if your challenge is upheld.

Adjusted scores will be reflected in the next update cycle. These scores and status on challenged data will be available for review on the ABVS web site.

Disputed data results when a challenge between contractor and government cannot be resolved.

While every effort will be made to expeditiously resolve disputed data, the government is the final authority for its resolution and use in the source selection process, and may make an award decision despite the existence of unresolved challenges.

### **Using the ABVS score for evaluation**

FSC scores are used when offers are evaluated. If a vendor does not have a FSC score in that particular federal supply class, a vendor's DLA score is used to evaluate its offer.

The contracting officer may also consider the volume of business on which the FSC score is based as a measure of confidence in the score's indication of performance risk.

He may choose to use the DLA score if he lacks confidence in the FSC score.

The contracting officer also may use the DLA score if the FSC scores among offerors are relatively equal.

Offerors with no performance history will be not be evaluated favorably or unfavorably.

A "999.9" is used to designate those instances wherein the offeror is unscored -- that is, has no past performance history, has no history for the particular FSC or has no history for the timeframe being rated.



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


**PROJECTS OVERVIEW**

It has long been the perception that doing business with the DoD was a hard, slow, and often confusing process. This is a totally new look and feel for FirstGov. The redesigned site focuses on gateways for citizens, businesses, and government, and features online transactions. President Bush has called FirstGov, "the Front Door to my Administration's e-government initiative to make government more accessible to all Americans." GSA Administrator Stephen A. Perry described the FirstGov redesign, "significant progress in harnessing the power of technology to improve citizens interaction with their government."

The new FirstGov site is designed to connect visitors faster and more accurately with the transactions, services, and information that matter to them. Under the Citizens Gateway, visitors to the site can find helpful links under "Change Your Address," "Government Shopping," "E-File your Taxes," "Social Security OnLine," and much more. The Business Gateway offers links to information on "Business Opportunities," "Business Laws and Regulations," "Federal Auctions and Sales," and other helpful links. The Governments Gateway important information resources for federal, state, local, and tribal governments and employees such as grants, travel, government jobs, government sales and auctions, and the very latest concerning information technology.

In response to feedback from customers, FirstGov was redesigned to meet the public's desire to conduct more transactions online and to have government information organized specifically for citizens, businesses, and governments. Since its original launch in September 2000, visitors to FirstGov.gov have found it easy to find Web-based information, services, and transactions on federal, state, and local government Web sites. More people have been finding it more efficient to go online than to waste valuable time standing in line to work with government.
